Training Fees are Due

To maintain a sports club we need to charge two sets of fees one to cover costs of membership of the club (this fee will cover athlete registration which is due to become mandatory during 2007 as well as assisting with purchasing equipment) and a further fee to cover costs of conducting each training session.

The weekly or season training fee which you pay is used to pay for training facilities, this money is not paid to coaches who all give their time for free.

We are maintaining the fees we have charged for the past few years, these are as follows:

£20 for Outdoor training;
£30 for Indoor training;

Or £2 per session attended

The fee is calculated to make a saving for those who plan to attend most of the sessions we run during a season and the break down is as follows and allows for holidays:
